




BOX 3 BUTTERFLIES

Assembly instructions

Supplied materials

- Cut-out pieces.
- Rubber stopper.
- 3 metal rods.
- A wooden stick.
- A bottle.
- Sand.



Necessary materials (not supplied)


- A needle.
- Round nose pliers.
- A piece of thick cardboard.
- Cutting pliers.

Advice

- Start by taking all the items out of the box to fully understand the contents and which cut-outs make up each butterfly stem.
- Handle cut-outs and stems with care.



Using the stick, curl the butterfly wings to bring them to life. Gently stretch the wings by placing them between the stick and your thumb.





Place the 3 butterflies on top of each other in order of size.





With the three cut-outs on top of each other place on the cardboard and make a hole in the center using the needle and set aside.

Form a loop at the end of the 3 rods.



Thread a rod through the hole and slide the butterflies (from smallest to largest) to the loop.

Do the same with the rubber stopper.

Repeat the exercise for the other two butterfly stems.

You have composed your bouquet of butterflies. It's time to unscrew the cap from the small bottle and plant your pretty creation in it.



- Using the stick, curve and bend the cutouts to bring them to life.
- Use wire cutters to adjust the height of your rods.



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Not suitable for children under 3 years old. The presence of an adult is recommended for children under 10 years old. Some parts of the box (rods, rubber stoppers, glass bottle, etc.) can be dangerous and cause injuries during handling.
